New Mexico sits in FEMA Region 6 and hosts critical nuclear weapons infrastructure — Kirtland AFB is home to the Air Force Nuclear Weapons Center and stores the largest stockpile of nuclear weapons in the world. White Sands Missile Range is the largest military installation in the US by area (3,200 sq miles). Sandia and Los Alamos National Laboratories design all US nuclear warheads. Cannon AFB hosts AFSOC special operations.
